Pick and Pack



OVERVIEW

Understandably, wholesale distribution businesses and e-retailers (those selling on the web) focus first and foremost on sales. A small investment in the warehouse can pay big dividends in order fulfilment by delivering to the customer exactly what they ordered in the quickest way possible.

Achieve this, and you are well on your way to improved customer satisfaction and loyalty.

Pick and Pack involves identifying the goods to be dispatched, physically picking them from stock or warehouse shelves, wrapping and packaging the goods and producing delivery dockets/invoices.

BENEFITS

It is particularly useful in warehouse environments where the goods to be despatched are unable to be presented in either order or picking slip sequence. The Pick and Pack method of data entry can facilitate the entry of despatch details in any sequence.

FEATURES

- » Scan or enter stock codes and quantities against an order in any sequence.
- » Automatically confirms that the quantity of the item entered is actually on this order.
- » Scan Serial & Lot Numbers
- » Can handle multiple entries against a single line item (e.g. Scan individual items.
- » Has a switchable entry mode between scan mode (default qty of 1) and manual entry mode.
- » Allows Pick and Pack processing at either the delivery stage or invoice stage.
- » Allows sorting of product lines in any sequence based on the tabs at the top of the products. Especially useful if required sort by bin location.
- » Add additional product lines to the order such as freight or other charges.
- » Quantity and value totals update on screen as each product item is picked.
- » Can show order custom fields and display customer notes.

The Pick and Pack module is a specialised entry process and as such does not allow manipulation of the original order or any variation entry. All unsupplied items remain on backorder.

When Save & Close is selected the resultant invoice is processed in the normal ABM manner.
